Bridge Classes at the North Dartmouth Branch



Starting Tuesday February 17th! 1:00 pm-3:00pm

Presented by Russ Carey, this course is designed for participants who have never played any type of bridge or for neophyte contract bridge players who wish to become better grounded in the basics. The course will consist of ten sessions, each two hours in length. Participants will learn basic bridge terms, the deal, the bidding ladder, valuing hands, opening bids, choosing a trump suit, responses to opening bids, furthering the bidding, strategies for making contracts, strategies for defeating contracts, overcalls, responses to overcalls, a few key bidding conventions and scoring. Each class will include lesson time and playing time. The course will be held each Tuesday at the North Dartmouth Branch Library, 1383 Tucker Road from 1:00pm-3:00pm, February 17-April 21, 2009.
